Artistic CV

Damiano Picci, a composer, entrepreneur, and producer from Luxembourg, developed a passion for music at the young age of five through music lessons. Initially learning elementary music theory, he was soon drawn to the saxophone, studying under David Reiland at the UGDA music school.

At 12 years old, Damiano ventured further into the world of music, embarking on several years of lessons at the Luxembourg Conservatory. His studies included classical harmony with Romain Becker, jazz theory with David Laborier, jazz saxophone with Roby Glod, jazz combo with David Laborier, jazz bass guitar with Romain Heck, electroacoustic music with Claude Lenners, piano with Pierre Alzin, jazz analysis with David Laborier, jazz harmony with David Laborier, and jazz history with Guy Cabay.

As his interest in popular music styles grew, Damiano began taking pop/rock bass lessons from Laurent Peckels. During this period, he formed his first pop/rock bands and gained invaluable live performance experience. Damiano's fascination with computer music expanded, leading to the creation of intriguing works, such as an electro-acoustic piece premiered at the Philharmonic during the Rainy Days festival. After graduating from the music department at the Athénée de Luxembourg, Damiano chose to pursue a degree in Sound and Music Production. Throughout his studies, he developed an increasing interest in multimedia installations and began incorporating algorithms into his compositions.

In 2016, Damiano launched his first solo project, Mudaze. Under this moniker, he merged experimental music with jazz and contemporary electronic sounds. This unique fusion led to a series of concerts, including opening acts for Hippy Sabotage, Gramatik, Petit Biscuit, and performances at festivals like Sonic Visions Festival and Siren's Call Festival.

During his studies, Damiano's passion for spatial sound, particularly multi-channel sound installations, flourished. He embarked on his initial projects involving 3D sound, lighting, and interactivity, pushing the boundaries of traditional audio experiences. As a freelance programmer and sound designer, Damiano collaborated with Kling Klang Klong Berlin on various projects, further honing his skills and expanding his creative repertoire in the realm of immersive and interactive audio environments.

Finally, after an enriching experience at Galaxy Studios in Antwerp, where he gained invaluable expertise in spatial sound and orchestral music, Damiano returned to Luxembourg with a renewed focus on composing music for dance, theater, and immersive installations. In his work, he not only employs traditional composition techniques but also delves into the conceptualization and design of musical interactive artificial intelligences and generative music systems. By pushing the boundaries between music and coding, Damiano continues to explore the vast potential of creative expression in the digital age, further expanding the horizons of his artistic endeavors.
